

1. The accused admits the acts alleged in paragraphs 12 to 44 of the Summary of Prosecution Opening, although he denies knowledge that the green Kawasaki off-road motorcycle was stolen.
2. The accused maintains that he was acting under duress at all times during the 'Westside Hotel Incident'.

ATAK STORAGE

3. The accused admits possession of the four firearms found in the ATAK storage containers, but denies possession of the precursor chemicals and the nine motorcycles.

LA PORCHETTA INCIDENT


4. The accused admits the acts alleged in paragraphs 61 to 74 of the Summary of Prosecution Opening, save that he maintains that:
 - a. At no stage did any member of the police state that they were police members;
 - b. He did not say words to the effect of "Fuck off or I'll shoot ya", rather said words to the effect of "Fuck off. Fuck off.";
 - c. KASSIS caught up with him, grabbed him on the right shoulder and aggressively spun him around.
5. The accused maintains he was acting in self defence in raising the firearm.

KEILOR EAST SEIGE

6. The accused admits firing five shots on 21 May 2012. The accused maintains that when he fired these shots at or near the SOG armoured vehicle:
 - a. He did not cause any of the complainants to apprehend the immediate application of force to that complainant's body; and
 - b. He did not intend to cause any of the complainants to apprehend the immediate application of force to that complainant's body
 - c. In any event, he was acting in self defence.

7. The accused admits firing four shots on 22 May 2012. The accused maintains that when he fired those shots he did not place people in danger of death or serious injury.
