Tonight, are you talking about in the evening of Tuesday, or are you talking about - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

No.

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

Last night, or - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

No, no, no, no. In the evening of Tuesday.

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

Okay.

LORETTA COLLIER:

Like, tonight.

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

So it was - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

Tonight, he - - -?

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

..... in the last two hours.

LORETTA COLLIER:

Yeah. Tonight, he did those shots when the police did the rubber stuff.

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

Okay.

LORETTA COLLIER:

When he did a couple of - I don't even know how many shots he did tonight, I don't know. I - I just went into the bathroom and I went into the shower, and I was in the basin man I closed the door, I had a towel over my head, I didn't want to know, I freaked it.

Could you guess how many - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

I did-, - -

Shots he fired - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

I didn't even hear.

Tonight?

And basically, all I heard was the police doing those shots, and I just freaked out and I just got off that mattress and I just ran into the bathroom, and then while I'm running into the bathroom, then he's obviously done a shot or two, but - - -

How can - how can you be confident that he - he fired shots, if there is - you say that there's police shooting - - -?

LORETTA COLLIER:

Yep.

DETECTIVE SENIOR CONSTABLE QUINNELL:

Objects through into the house - - -?

Yep.
