To the Registrar of Criminal Appeals:

I, Christopher Dean Binse am convicted of the offenses of: 3x Prohibited person possess firearm; 1 Theft, 1x Armed robbery; 1x Reckless conduct that may place another person in danger of serious injury, and I am a prisoner at Barwon Prison, 1140 Bacchus Marsh Road Lara Victoria.

I APPLY to the Registrar of Criminal Appeals under section 313 of the CPA for an extension of time within which to file and serve a notice of Notion of Appeal or Notice of application to appeal to the Court of appeal under Part 6.3 of Chapter of the Act (particulars of which are set out below).

The reason I failed to file and serve a notice within the prescribed time and the grounds on which I make this application are:

1. The actions of my solicitor and barrister amount to the actus reus of attempting to pervert the course of justice. And a matter that is attended by such conduct is a nullity and it cannot be allowed to stand.
2. My solicitor and barrister denied the Court knowledge of the true facts and

circumstances of my case in relation to my suffering mental disturbance associated with PTSD.

3. My solicitor and barrister denied the Court knowledge of the true facts and circumstances of my case and presented a false and misleading version of the facts and circumstances.
4. I was coerced by my solicitor and barrister into entering a plea of guilty against my will.
5. My suffering from the mental disturbance associated with PTSD has significantly impacted upon my liabilities to address my legal matters in a time fashion.
6. Evidence that I ask be considered in relation to the granting of an extension of time is particularized in an affidavit filed this this supplication.
